



Notice of road closure, A4010 Risborough Road

What are we doing?

Realigning the A4010 Risborough Road – From late October there will be several road closures around Stoke Mandeville. They are required to complete the realignment of the A4010 Risborough Road onto the new A4010 Stoke Mandeville Relief Road (SMRR) and to complete of Phase 2 of Buckinghamshire Councils South East Aylesbury Link Road (SEALR).

From early November, the A4010 will open on its new alignment in conjunction with Phase 2 of Buckinghamshire Councils' SEALR.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closures and a signposted diversion route for traffic will be in place. To complete the required finishing works and open the new road, we will be working up to 24 hours a day with consent from Buckinghamshire Council during this period.

The new spur connecting Old Risborough Road will open later in November. The section of the former A4010 Risborough Road north of Old Risborough Road towards Stoke Mandeville will be permanently closed.

When will these works take place?

- **Friday 24 October 7pm to 6am Friday 31 October** – the B4443 Lower Road will be closed by Buckinghamshire Council.
- **Friday 31 October 9am to 5:30am Wednesday 5 November** – the A4010 Risborough Road will be closed. It will not re-open on its former alignment after this date.
- **Wednesday 5 November** – the new A4010 Stoke Mandeville Relief Road will open to the public.
- **Wednesday 19 November** – the spur linking the Old Risborough Road and Bucks Goat Centre to the relief road will open. The original A4010 Risborough Road will be permanently closed

Provide updates for communities and maintain regular contact with emergency services.

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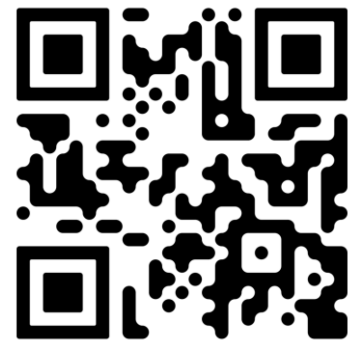
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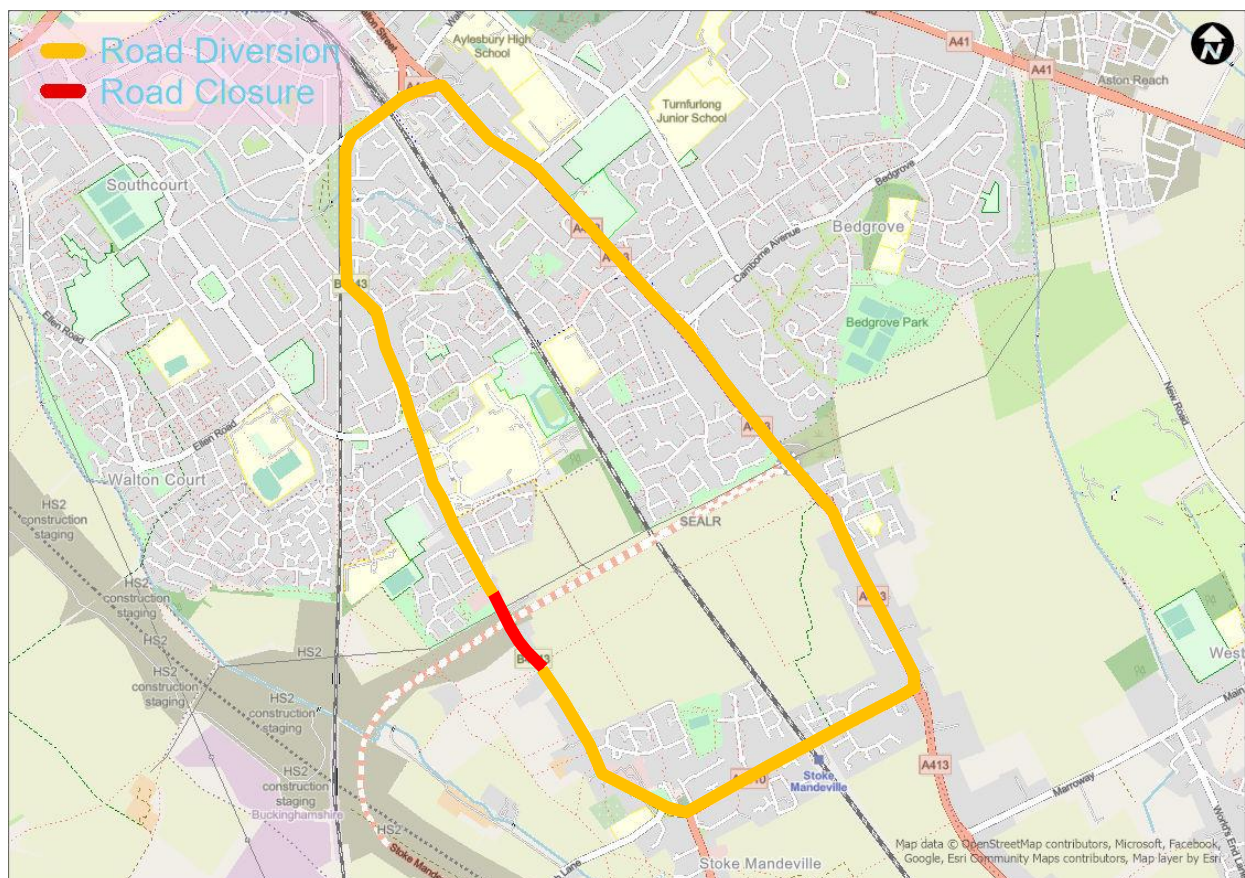

Friday 24 October 7pm – 6am Friday 31 October B4443 Lower Road closure - the map below shows location of the road closure and diversion route for the B4443 Lower Road. These works are managed by Buckinghamshire Council and relate to the Lower Road roundabout as part of the South East Aylesbury Link Road (SEALR) project. Access for pedestrians and blue light services will be maintained.

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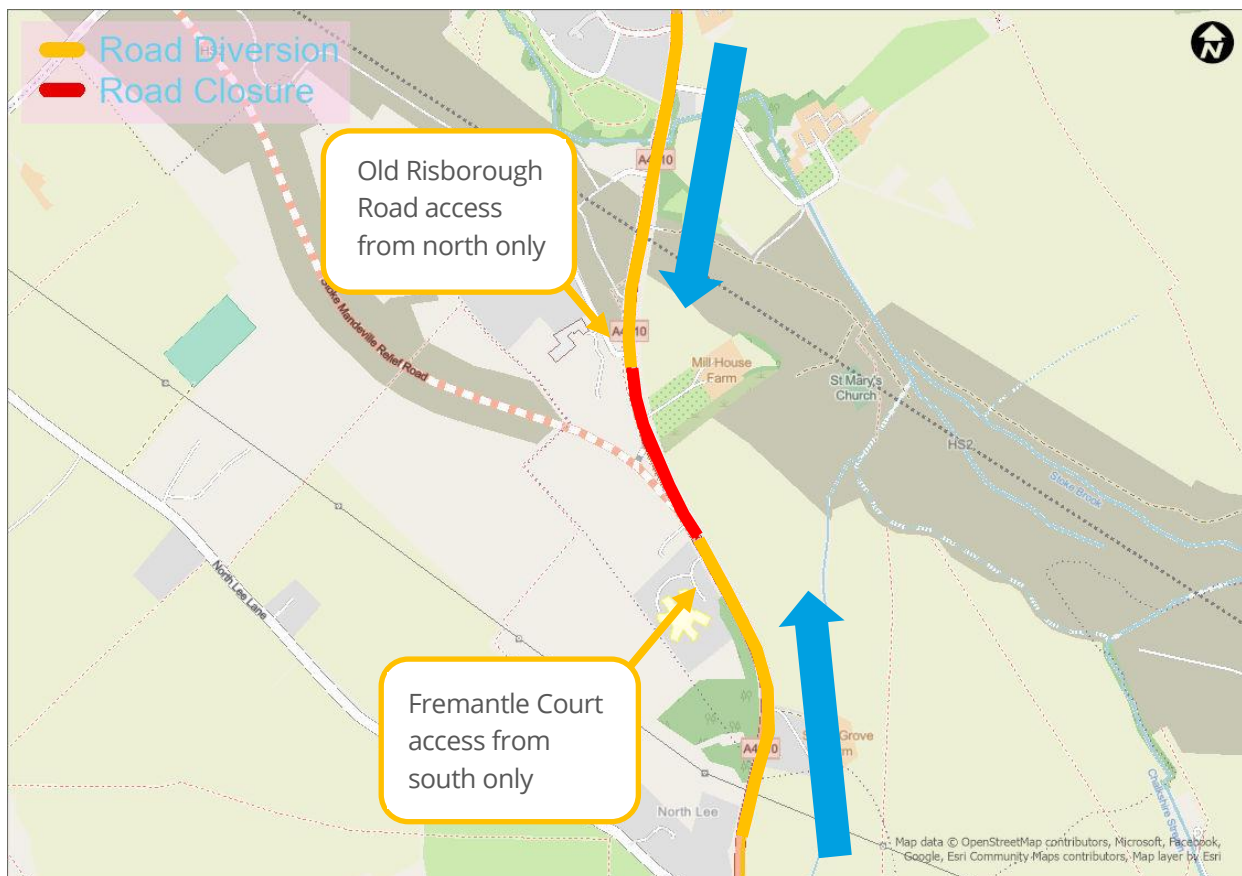
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Where will these works take place?

Friday 31 October 9am – 5:30am Wednesday 5 November A4010 road closure - the map below shows location of the road closure on the A4010 Risborough Road.



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Where will these works take place? (con't)

Friday 31 October 9am to 5:30am Wednesday 5 November - the map below shows the road closure and diversion route for the A4010 Risborough Road.

Access for residents and businesses along the A4010 Risborough Road will be maintained via the signed diversion route. Access to Old Risborough Road, the Bucks Goat Centre and Layby Farm will be maintained along the existing A4010 from the north only, via Stoke Mandeville. Access to Fremantle Court Nursing Home and Harvest Petrol Station will be maintained along the existing A4010 from the south only, via Terrick.

We have been advised that all of these businesses will be open as usual.



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Where will these works take place? (con't)

Wednesday 5 November to Wednesday 19 November - The map below shows the new A4010 Stoke Mandeville Relief Road (SMRR) open. The former A4010 Risborough Road remains closed for finishing works to the spur linking to the Old Risborough Road and Bucks Goat Centre. Phase 2 of the South East Aylesbury Link Road (SEALR), built by Buckinghamshire Council, is shown in blue.



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Where will these works take place? (con't)

From Wednesday 19 November old A4010 permanent closure – the map below shows the new A4010 Stoke Mandeville Relief Road (SMRR) in operation and the old A4010 Risborough Road permanently stopped up, although no through access will be in place from 31 October. Phase 2 of the South East Aylesbury Link Road (SEALR), built by Buckinghamshire Council, is shown in blue.
